

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

### WCR 7 – WATER TRANSMISSION PIPELINE – PHASE 3 LEFT HAND WATER DISTRICT

1. Sealed Bids for the Work hereinafter described will be received by the Left Hand Water District (hereinafter referred to as Owner) at 6800 Nimbus Road, Niwot, Colorado until 3:00 p.m. on April 23, 2021, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. Bids may be deposited at the above Owner's address from 9:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, or mailed to the Owner, P.O. Box 210, Niwot, Colorado 80544.
2. Copies of the Bid Documents may be obtained from [questcdn.com](http://questcdn.com) under Quest eBidDoc #7721427 for \$15 as of March 29, 2021. No paper sets will be sold. NO REFUNDS OF PAYMENTS WILL BE MADE. The Bid Documents may be examined for no charge at the Owner's office or at the office of the Engineer (Dewberry Engineers Inc. at 990 South Broadway, Suite 400, Denver, Colorado). All proposals shall be submitted in accordance with the "Instructions to Bidders" and other related documents collectively referred to as the Bid Documents.
3. The Work to be performed under the provisions of these Bid Documents consists of the complete construction, including all Work appurtenant thereto, of the Weld County Road (WCR) 7 – Water Transmission Pipeline – Phase 3 project. This Work more specifically consists of the installation of approximately 6,730 lineal feet of 24-inch diameter steel treated water pipeline along WCR 7 between WCR 10 and the Arneson Tank site south of Erie Parkway/WCR 8. Pipeline installation work includes the trenchless installation of approximately 110 lineal feet of 36-inch diameter steel casing and 24-inch diameter carrier pipe across Erie Parkway. Pipeline installation work also includes approximately 425 lineal feet of 12-inch diameter C900 PVC treated water pipe. Pipeline appurtenances include isolation valves, fire hydrants, air and vacuum relief valve assemblies, blow off assemblies, and connections to existing distribution pipelines. Work will include all site preparation, erosion and sedimentation control, traffic control, pipeline construction, two (2) open-cut ditch crossings, installation of all associated appurtenances, site and road restoration, and dewatering as required. It is strongly recommended that the prospective bidders investigate the site of the Work sufficiently to satisfy themselves of the extent and conditions of the project.
4. A mandatory Pre-Bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. April 8, 2021 via a Microsoft Teams meeting. All questions shall be sent by email to [jtspencer@dewberry.com](mailto:jtspencer@dewberry.com). The last day for questions is April 15, 2021, at 5:00 p.m.
5. Bidder Qualification forms are included in the Bid Documents. Bidders must be qualified contractors in the State of Colorado. Bids received from Bidders who are not recorded by the Owner as having received the Bid Documents will not be opened.
6. Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total Bid Price must accompany each Bid in the form specified in the Instructions to Bidders.
7. The Successful Bidder, upon acceptance of the Contract, shall be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond executed by a corporate surety authorized to do business in Colorado and acceptable to the Owner for the full amount called for in the Contract.
8. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informalities or defects, to award the Contract to the Bidder who the Owner believes is a responsible Bidder, and to re-solicit bids if it is deemed to be in the Owner's best interests. Nothing in the Bid Documents should be construed as an obligation of the Owner to award the Contract to the lowest Bidder.
